Frequently Asked Questions

R U OK? Program

The R U OK? program is a free program designed to check up on our Brazos County Senior and Homebound Citizens, living alone, residing outside of the city limits of Bryan-College Station. Each week at a pre-arranged time volunteers working out of the Brazos County Sheriff's Office will place a call to our senior and homebound clients.

What is this program?

This is a free program for seniors over 65 years of age or homebound citizens who live alone and do not have anyone to check on them.

How does the program work?

A volunteer will call the client at a designated day and time each week.

What happens if I do not answer?

If the volunteer calls and the client does not answer, a deputy will be dispatched to conduct a wellness check and ensure the client is ok.

How do I enroll in the program?

Fill out an application and return the form to the Brazos County Sheriff's Office.



Benefits of the Program

Contacting a senior or homebound citizen on a weekly basis helps reassure their well-being and gives them a feeling of security.

Provides family members the peace of mind that someone is checking in on their loved one.
